

Minutes of the 112th Annual General Meeting of the Manchester Pickwick Club held at the Moorside Social Club on 18th April, 2018

The meeting was opened at 8.03 p.m. when it was reported that George Nupkin was absent through illness but introducing a new member, Paul Campbell, who was given the pickwick name Nat Winkle.

Before Dodson had an opportunity to speak, Pickwick reminded him that the A.G.M. was normally a free evening; Dodson said that had Mr Pickwick not ordered him to be quiet he would have already advised members that this would be a free evening!
